Associate Member – a person whose products or services support the design profession.

Student – a person who is currently enrolled as a full-time student in an accredited program leading to a certificate or degree in architecture, engineering, interior design, or with a professed interest in applying their studies to the professional administration of such businesses.

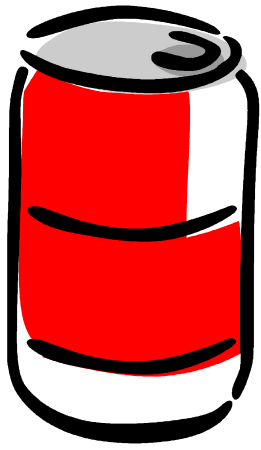

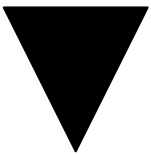
